September 7, 1919 - September 4, 2018

Leona Regner passed away peacefully on September 4, 2018 at the Wishek Living Center, surrounded by her family. She was born September 7, 1919 to Emilia (Retzlaff) and Wm. Becker. Leona was the oldest of eleven children growing up in the Streeter Flat area. She grew to adulthood in the Napoleon, Burnstad area.
