



Wesley "Bud" Ten Pas

February 1, 1925 - October 14, 2012

Wesley Harvey Ten Pas was born on February 1, 1925 in Valley City, ND to Henry and Minnie (Joling) Ten Pas. He attended school in Litchville and Hastings, ND.

Bud lived and farmed his entire life in the Litchville community. The only time he left was during his years serving in the US Army. He entered active duty on January 30, 1945, being stationed in the Asiatic-Pacific Theatre and Japan. He was with the 320th Engineers. His honorable discharge was received on December 2, 1946.

On February 1, 1951, he married Luella Liebing of Marion, ND in Litchville. They made their home north of Litchville.

He was a member of the First Reformed Church of Litchville. He also belonged to the Leslie Neumann Post 1935 since 1962 and a life member since 1976.

Bud died at the Hennepin County Medical Center in Minneapolis. He is survived and loved dearly by his wife, Luella; children, Duane of Litchville, Sandra (Steve) Bergeson of Fargo, ND, and Connie (Kenton) Pontius of Titusville, FL; grandchildren, Ryan, Austin, and Tyler; and many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, 8 sisters, and a brother.
