



## Ahmed Kamoni

September 16, 1936 - January 27, 2010

Ahmed Bernard Kamoni was born on September 16, 1936 in Pettibone, ND the son of Ahmed and Marie (Von Seggern) Kamoni. He attended school there and graduated in 1954. He served in the United States Army from 1955-1957.

In 1959, he married Virginia Redinger. He also began working for the ND State Water Conservation Commission that year.

In 1960, he began drilling water wells with his brother Al as Kamoni Water Wells. In 1972, he moved with his sons to Valley City, ND. In 1987, he married Judine Lindemann and they ran the business together from 1987 until retiring in 1997. At that time, Ahmed's nephew, Wayne, took over the family business. He was a lifetime member of the American Legion and VFW and a past member of the Elks Club and Eagles Aerie. He was an outdoorsman and enjoyed hunting and fishing. Ahmed was also known to like to play a game or two of cards.

Ahmed is survived by his wife, Judine of Valley City; sons, Blaine and Clay (Sharlene) both of Jamestown, ND; grandchildren, Ryan Botner, Jena and Spencer Kamoni; brother, Allen (Ella Jean) of Pettibone; sisters, Wanda (Bill) Homan of Bismarck, ND, Dorothy (Les) Loch of St. Cloud, MN, and Virginia (James) Finney of North Charleston, SC; and many nieces and nephews.
