Allen Edgar Latt was born on May 2, 1926 in Valley City, ND, the son of Victor and Julia (Brock) Latt. He was a 1944 graduate of Valley City High School then attended Valley City State University for a quarter. In 1944, he enlisted in the US Navy and served his country until 1946. Following his discharge, he returned to Valley City and worked at the Pegg Garage for 2 years.

On August 2, 1947, he was united in marriage to Frances Kriedlkamp at Trinity Lutheran Church in Valley City. Allen and Frances made their home on her grandmother's farm near Cuba, ND. In 1960, they purchased a farm near Litchville, ND. In 1985, they moved into Litchville and later moved to Valley City, ND. They had recently moved into The Legacy Place there.

He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church where he was baptized, confirmed and married. While they were living in the Litchville area he served on the First Lutheran Church Council and was on the Skandia Township Board for over 20 years. He was a member of the VFW, American Legion, DAV, and Eagles.

Allen is survived by his wife, Frances; sons, Dennis (Colleen) of Vancouver, WA and Rodney (Belinda) of Litchville; daughters, Vicki Jo (Wayne) Urban of Custer, SD and Pamela Kay (Royce) Braley of Fargo, ND; 15 grandchildren; 26 great grandchildren; and a sister, Doris (Jim) Mickelson of Seattle, WA. He was preceded in death by his parents and a granddaughter, Sara Latt.
