Arvid Benny Dagman was born on May 10, 1913 near Nome, ND, the son of Axel and Ida (Benson) Dagman. He attended Raritan School near Nome. Following his schooling, he moved to Fargo, ND where he was a milk delivery man. While living in Fargo, he met Alma Johnson. They were married on June 21, 1939. They made their home in rural Barnes and Ransom counties where they farmed. In 1963, they moved to Valley City, ND. Arvid did carpentry work in the Valley City area. He helped build many homes there. One of the larger projects he helped on was the building of the North Dakota Wintershow building.

He was a charter member of Elim Evangelical Free Church.
