Bobby Ray Simmons was born October 4, 1931 in Guthrie, OK, the son of the late Jeff Lloyd and Blonnie (Moore) Simmons. He was the oldest of 8 siblings. He lived in Missouri until his family moved to Bell Gardens, CA in 1947. He worked at a Mobil gas station as an attendant after school and weekends. In 1950, he delivered ice before joining the National Guard (40th Military Police). The government mobilized him into the Army. He left the Army to go back to Wyatt, MO to work on a family farm. In August of 1950, he joined the Navy and served in the Korean War.

He married Vallie D. Komrosky, April 19, 1957 in Bell Gardens. They made their home in California until 1962. They lived in Nevada and Montana until moving to St. Francis, MN in 1968. He was a certified fireman and licensed paramedic and was employed at Elk River Ford in Elk River, MN as a mechanic until their move to Phoenix, AZ in 1978. They moved to Oriska, ND in 1990. He was employed by the Oriska School District. When he retired, he did scrap clean up and salvage. After losing the love of his life for 39 years on February 17, 1996, he spent winters in Drumright, OK and Phoenix, AZ. He loved to fish, go to the horse races, eat out, and to modulate on his CB.
