Christopher George Watkins was born September 10, 1962 in Charlotte, NC, the son of Arthur and Colleen (Nelson) Watkins. He grew up in Detroit Lakes, MN and attended First Baptist Church. He then moved to the Fargo/Moorhead area and graduated from Fargo North High School in 1980. Chris spent many of the next years in the food service industry.
