He was raised on a farm and attended grade school at Straubville School and he went on to attend high school at Cogswell graduating in 1957. Dave worked for the North Dakota State Highway Department for 48 years, retiring in November of 2007.

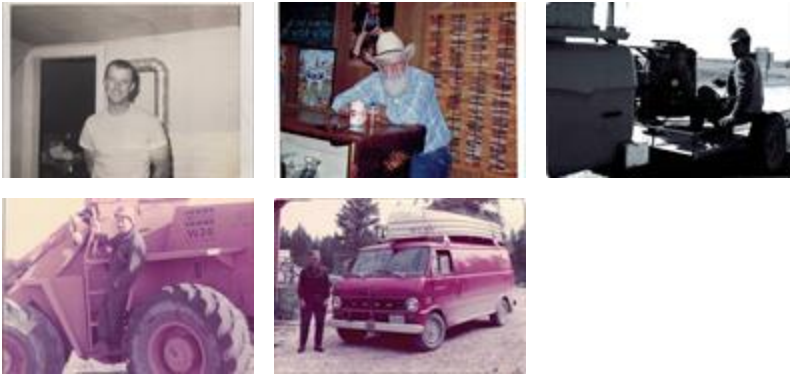
