Deanna Rae (Olson) Arneson passed away at home on May 10, 2019 at the age of 58. She was born on October 21, 1960 to Jane and Leonard Olson. It was a beautiful fall day when she was born. She was a very active child. She attended Oriska Elementary School and then Oriska High School graduating in the spring of 1978.

During her high school years Deanna worked at the Sheyenne Care Center deciding she would like to go into nursing. In 1980, she graduated from NDSSS with a LPN degree. Deanna returned to the care center and also worked at the North Dakota State Hospital in Jamestown, ND. On February 3, 1989 she married Jim Arneson. In 1994, Deanna and James moved to California. 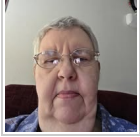

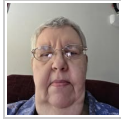
