



Dorothy Young

October 3, 1929 - June 17, 2013

Dorothy Jane Trader was born October 3, 1929 in Oriska, ND to Charles J. and Emma (Priebe) Trader. She was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church. She attended Oriska Public School. At the age of 18, she moved to Valley City, ND and worked at Foss Drug, DeBolts Café, and the 21 Club.

On February 15, 1951, she married Clarence W. Young in South Dakota. Twelve hours later, he left for Korea where he was stationed for ten months. Following his return, they made their home in Getchell Township, near Valley City, ND, where they farmed for 16 years. The couple moved to Valley City and Dorothy worked at Mercy Hospital as well as Warrens Bakery, Woolworths and Enterprises Sales. She retired in 1990. Clarence died February 8, 2004. Dorothy continued to make her home in Valley City. She was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church.

Dorothy died at Sanford Health in Fargo, ND on June 17, 2013.
