The funeral for Duane "Dewey" Bayliss, 68, Enderlin, North Dakota will be 2 pm Friday, September 15, 2023, in the chapel at Maryhill Manor, Enderlin. Visitation will be one hour before the service in the chapel. Burial will be in the Enderlin Cemetery. He passed away on Friday afternoon, September 8, with his sister by his side.

Duane Douglas Bayliss was born November 16, 1954, in Enderlin to Arthur L. and Selma H. (Kopperud) Bayliss. He attended and graduated from Enderlin High School in 1973. Dewey worked for the city of Enderlin and later for the Enderlin Park Board. He then helped his father at the scrap yard until 1980. After the death of his father, he helped his mother by driving her to places as she was not able to do so. Dewey became a resident of Maryhill Manor on December 8, 2015.

Dewey liked to fish as the river was only a few blocks from home. He caught lots of bullheads but also caught a few keeper northern pike to eat.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a brother Arthur, Jr., and an infant brother Curtis.
