E. Edgar Storhoff was born May 23, 1914 to Adolph and Lena (Rodlin) Storhoff at Eastedge, North Dakota. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Petri Lutheran Church of Nome, North Dakota. Edgar attended school at Eastedge. He worked for area farmers in North Dakota. In 1941, he went to Portland, Oregon and worked in the shipyards. He was drafted into the United States Army in 1942 and served in the South Pacific until his discharge in 1945.

Edgar farmed with his brother until retiring and moving to Valley City. He later moved to Maryhill Manor.

He is survived by one sister, Valborg Hoff of Bismarck, North Dakota; four brothers, Gerhard of Enderlin; Edmund of Nome; Howard of Seattle, Washington; Richard of Moorhead, Minnesota and many nieces and nephews.
