Elverna Becker, 90, died peacefully on May 10, 2021 at Sheyenne Care Center in Valley City, ND.

Elverna was born April 8, 1931 in Wimbledon, ND. She was the daughter of Art and Freda Oglesby. She married Clifford Becker on November 3, 1948 and they made their home on a farm near Dazey, ND where they raised six children. Elverna was a full time wife and mother.

She always maintained a large garden on the farm and was well known for her baking abilities, especially for her pies, pastries and freshly baked bread.
