Erna Helēna (Koebernick) Anderson, 92, of Valley City, ND passed away peacefully at the Sheyenne Care Center, Valley City, ND in the presence of family on November 6, 2021, under the care of CHI Hospice.

Erna was born December 28, 1928 in Mercer, ND to Emil and Emma (Raap) Koebernick. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. In 1941, the family moved to Sanborn. After graduating from Sanborn High School in 1948, Erna worked at First National Bank in Valley City. Erna married the love of her life, Lloyd Severt Anderson on December 22, 1951 in Valley City. They made their home and farmed in Hobart Township, SW Valley City. They were members of Our Savior's Lutheran Church, Valley City. They were blessed with six children, three boys and three girls, David, Bruce, Glenn, Lori, Doreen

and Julie. In 1975, their oldest son, David Lloyd, was killed in an accident. In 2011, they moved to Valley City and in December 2018 they became residents of the Sheyenne Care Center in Valley City. Their marriage of 67 years created a legacy that will be passed down for generations to come. Lloyd died on May 18, 2019.

Erna had a passion for music, singing, dancing, gardening, baking, sewing, playing cards, and amusement park rides as well as spending time and traveling with family and friends. Erna will be remembered for her immense love of her family, devoted faith, strong work ethic, and relentless desire to help others.
