Gary Gene Justesen, age 82, of Fargo, ND, formerly of Litchville, ND, passed away peacefully with family by his side on April 1, 2025, at Chandler Regional Medical Center. He was born on December 7, 1942, in Chicago, IL, to Ray and Cora (Leidall) Justesen.

Gary graduated from Litchville High School in 1960. He then joined the Army National Guard and pursued a business degree from Interstate Business College in Fargo, ND. He began a long and dedicated career at Litchville State Bank, where he worked for over 30 years. Alongside his banking career, Gary proudly continued the family farming business, taking over operations from his father.

On June 15, 1963, Gary married the love of his life, Nancy Olafson, in Litchville. Together they made their home there for over 55 years, raising their three children: Terry, Tori, and Nicole. In January 2021, Gary and Nancy relocated to Fargo.
