Harold Sydney Erickson, 89, formerly of Litchville, ND passed away peacefully April 25, 2016 at Eventide, Jamestown, ND just short of his 90th birthday.

Harold was born April 27, 1926 to Anton and Ellen (Moen) Erickson. He attended country school and married Mavis Lorraine Olson on June 14, 1959 at First Lutheran Church, Litchville.

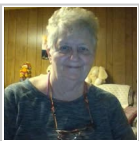
