Harriet Dimmer, 92, of Valley City, North Dakota passed away Monday, August 26, 2024, in CHI Mercy Health, Valley City. A funeral mass will be celebrated 10:30 AM, Saturday, August 31 at Holy Trinity Catholic Church, Fingal, North Dakota. Visitation will be Friday from 5-7 PM at Oliver-Nathan Funeral Chapel, Valley City. Visitation will continue Saturday at Holy Trinity from 9-10 AM with a rosary recited at 10 AM followed by the funeral mass. The burial will be in Holy Trinity Cemetery, Fingal.

Harriet Magdalen Weber was born March 25, 1932, in Springvale Township near Fingal, North Dakota, the daughter of John C. and Clara (Gruman) Weber. She attended the Wagner Country School and attended Fingal High School, graduating in 1950. In 1953, she received her teaching certificate from Valley City State College, Valley City.

On July 21, 1954, she was united in marriage to Gregory Dimmer. They made their home in Alice, North Dakota where she taught school for one year. She continued to teach for three more years in the Barnes County area before raising their family. In 1955, they began farming in the Fingal area until retiring and moving to Valley City.
