Hazel Reinke was born on September 26, 1929 near Nome, ND, the daughter of Hans and Anna (Johnson) Reinke. She attended the Lindvold School and graduated from Nome High School. Hazel continued her education by obtaining her teaching certificate from Valley City State University.

On October 23, 1948 she was united in marriage to LeVerne A. Sabby at the parsonage in Nome, ND. They made their home near Nome and farmed there until retiring in 2006. LeVerne died on January 7, 2008. Hazel continued to make her home on the farm until moving to Valley City. She was the first resident of The Legacy Place.

Hazel was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Nome. She loved spending time with her family and friends and was an avid BINGO player.

She is survived by her sons, Larry of Fargo and Terry of Nome; 8 grandchildren; and 7 great grandchildren.
