Jennifer Marie Alber, 33, of Marion, ND (formerly of South St. Paul, MN) shook the gates of Heaven with her arrival on May 24, 2011. She left her earthly home surrounded by her family at her father's home in Marion.

Jennifer was born in Jamestown, ND on November 9, 1977 to Larry and Vicki (Lenssen) Alber. She grew up in Marion, ND where she attended school. She graduated from Litchville-Marion Public School in 1997.

She began working at the Manor in LaMoure, ND while she was still in high school and became a CNA following her graduation. Jen graduated from Josef's School of Hair Design in Fargo and worked at various salons in the area and later in Minneapolis. In addition to being a stylist, she worked at Fargo Assembly and the motels in LaMoure and Oakes. Later she pursued a degree in accounting from Rasmussen College in Fargo, ND. After she received her degree, she went to work for Packaging Corporation of America in Golden Valley, MN.
