He graduated from North Central of Barnes and received a business degree from Valley City State College. Kim then started Homan Feed and Seed which he owned and operated for several years until its close.

Kim was united in marriage to Lynette Sowden in Valley City on September 14, 1990. His business involvement with ag sales led them to move around the state, eventually settling in Casselton.

After retirement Kim worked on his creation of Rough Rider Horse Water Fountains, manufacturing and selling them.

Kim enjoyed camping, fishing, traveling, gardening, and following the NDSU Bison.

Kim is survived by his wife Lynette, son Brandon Homan, and the family dog Nyx, all of Casselton; two step-sons, Todd (Steph) Blom of Tower City, North
