



Lloyd E. Schmidt

The funeral service for Lloyd E. Schmidt, 96, Valley City, North Dakota will be 10:30 am Saturday, April 8, 2017, at Our Savior's Lutheran Church, Valley City. Visitation will be one hour before the service at the church. Burial will be later in the spring at Memory Gardens, Valley City. He died Wednesday, April 5, at Sheyenne Care Center, Valley City.

Lloyd E. Schmidt was born October 6, 1920 in Bismarck, North Dakota, the son of Alexander and Elizabeth (Buck) Schmidt. He attended school in Medina, North Dakota. Lloyd married Meta Koslofsky on June 5, 1947 in Valley City.
