The funeral service for Lois Holden, 83, Valley City, ND, will be 1:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 21, 2011 at Faith Lutheran Church, Valley City. Rev. Dan Forsberg will officiate and burial will be in Fairview Cemetery, Sanborn, ND. She died at Sanford Health in Fargo, ND on June 17, 2011.
