



## Mabel Mulock

January 22, 1926 - May 13, 2010

Mabel Beatta Kinzler was born on January 22, 1926 in Velva, ND, the daughter of Otto and Helen (Garriott) Kinzler. Growing up, she lived in various ND towns, as her father was in the Methodist Ministry. She graduated from Milnor, ND High School in 1946 then went on to Asbury College in Kentucky where she studied music for 2 years.

On July 20, 1948, Mabel married Neil Mulock in Milnor. Her father presided over the ceremony. The couple made their home in Milnor and later moved to Hunter, ND.
