K. Marcella Colville was born on October 10, 1920 in rural Dazey, ND, the daughter of Walter and Marcia (Schoff) Colville. She attended rural school before moving with her family to Valley City, ND. In 1937, she graduated from College High in Valley City.

Marcella went on to attain her registered nursing certificate while working at Trinity Hospital in Jamestown, ND. She worked as an RN in Jamestown, Fargo and at Mercy Hospital in Valley City.

On January 13, 1958, she married August "Bud" Rohde in Moorhead, MN. They made their home near Oriska, ND. She raised her family and then returned to work. Marcella worked for many years at the Sheyenne Care Center. August died on November 22, 1996. She became a resident of the Sheyenne Care Center on June 20, 2002.
