She taught school for one year before her marriage to Robert (Bob) Koering on April 2, 1949. They made their home in Mayville and Hatton until Bob's job in the electrician field took them to Bottineau, Westhope and Newberg areas until 1964 when they made their permanent home in Valley City. Marion worked for the Fair Store for several years before retiring.

She was a member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church, Valley City. Marion helped out with Girl Scouts and was also a member of Beta Sigma Phi sorority. She was known for her entertaining and always had the coffee pot on. Her and Bob both liked to play cards so they spent time with friends playing games.
