



## Marjorie Fjeld

June 8, 1923 - November 29, 2010

Marjorie Lorraine Gustafson was born in Brockton, MT, June 8, 1923 to Florence (Whitney) and William Gustafson. Within weeks after Marjorie and her twin brother were born, their mother died. Her aunt and uncle, Hilma (Gustafson) and Lewis Jorgenson took her and her two brothers to their home in rural Barnes County, ND to raise.

She attended school in Kathryn, ND and went on to Valley City State Teachers College. She taught school in Barnes County, including Eastedge and the Lindvold School, before she married.

February 3, 1946 she married Evlyn Joseph Fjeld at Kathryn. They made their home near Kathryn. To this union, three children were born: Gary, Coralie, and John.

Marjorie and Evy farmed until moving into Valley City in 1984. She worked 14 years as a janitor's aide at Jefferson Elementary School in Valley City. Evy died on September 28, 2000.

She was a member of Grace Free Lutheran Church. She was a volunteer at the Barnes County Library for several years.

Marjorie died at her home on November 29, 2010.
