Marlene (Aus) Siedschlag was born April 4th, 1937. Daughter of Melvin and Vivian Aus. They lived in the Litchville, ND area, then moving to the Dazey and Rogers, ND area. They were members of Bethel Lutheran Church. She was confirmed in Rogers. She attended Rogers school and graduated in 1955. Marlene moved to Valley City and worked at Ace Hardware.

She was united in marriage to Doug Siedschlag August 3rd, 1958. They were blessed with 4 children. They had a new home built across from Pioneer Park and the kids ice skated and played ball and sure enjoyed their days in Valley City. In 1972, they moved to Gladstone, MI after quitting Municipal Utilities and worked as a Power Plant Supt. In 1974 Doug went to work for Basin Electric as Maintenance Supt and they lived in Hazen, ND. In 1978, they moved to Wheatland, WY where he worked as Mechanical Maintenance Supervisor. In 1990 retired and they moved back to Valley City.

Marlene was preceded in death by her sister Marion (3 months), her parents Melvin and Vivian Aus, Scott (son) Dec 16, 2010 in Casper, WY and her husband Douglas Siedschlag, July 31, 2014.

She is survived by three children, David Siedschlag, Gillette, WY, Lois (Dwight) Albers, Coon Rapids, MN, Mark (Becky) Siedschlag, Whitewood, SD, a daughter-in-law, Debbie Siedschlag, Casper, WY, 10 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren.
