Merilyn Jean (Larson) Peter died on Tuesday, February 24, 2009 at Mercy Hospital, Valley City, ND after a courageous battle with cancer.

Merilyn Jean (Larson) Peter was born September 26, 1938 in Valley City, ND, the daughter of Leonard and Sylvia (Amundson) Larson. Her family farmed in Noltimier Township where she attended school and graduated in 1956.
