Michael Glenn Feuerherm, 63, Valley City, North Dakota died Saturday, November 17, 2012 at Sanford Health, Fargo, North Dakota. Mike was born September 21, 1949 at Carrington, North Dakota, the son of Ernest and Carol (Hanft) Feuerherm. Mike worked with his dad as a brick tender in his high school years. He graduated from VCHS in 1967. Mike then worked on oil rigs in Wyoming and Texas before entering the US Navy. He was stationed on the USS Samuel Gompers during Vietnam.
