



Mildred Schroeder

January 14, 1909 - October 4, 2011

Mildred Gladys Marshall was born January 14, 1909 on the family farm in Alta Township, Barnes County, ND to John H and Helena “Lena” (Noeske) Marshall. She was baptized at her home and confirmed in the Methodist faith.

Mildred graduated from Noltimier Consolidated School near Valley City. She then attended Valley City Teachers College receiving a teacher’s certificate and a special in primary teaching. Mildred taught school in Cass County for one year before returning to teach at Noltimier Consolidated School from 1930 to 1935.

On July 11, 1935, Mildred married Fred W. Schroeder at the Salem United Methodist Church in Noltimier Township. They resided on the Schroeder home farm for three years before moving into Valley City in 1938. At the age of 99, Mildred became a resident of Sheyenne Care Center also in Valley City.

Mildred was a member of Salem United Methodist church, rural Valley City where she taught Sunday school for many years, and served as president of the United Methodist Women’s group for twenty years, as well as many other capacities in the church organization. At the time of Salem’s closure Mildred transferred her membership to Epworth United Methodist Church. Through the years Mildred remained very active in various community organizations including: the Women’s Division of the North Dakota Winter Show, Sheyenne Care Center Board and Auxiliary, Business and Professional Women, and Retired Teachers Association.

Mildred died at Sheyenne Care Center on October 4, 2011. She is survived by two sons, Fred D (Dorothy) Schroeder of Valley City; and Darrell J (Rebecca) Schroeder of Oriska, ND; six grandchildren James (Darla) Schroeder, Ann (Walter) Rolf, Holly Schroeder, Craig (Kya) Schroeder, Dawn (Jason) Goehring, and Apryl (Jim) Schreiner; and ten great-grandchildren. Mildred was preceded in death by her parents; husband; infant daughter; two sisters; two brothers; one sister-in-law; and a nephew.
