The memorial service for Nancy Jo Rangeloff, of Nome, North Dakota will be 1:00 pm, Saturday, June 25, 2022 at Standing Rock Cemetery, Fort Ransom, North Dakota. Nancy passed away on Saturday, February 5, 2022. The service will be followed by burial (inurnment) with her husband Les Rangeloff who passed away Monday, May 24, 2021.

Nancy Rangeloff, 71 of Nome, North Dakota, died on Saturday, February 5, 2022 at Sanford Hospital, Fargo, North Dakota.

Nancy Jo Moorberg was born to Joseph and Leona Moorberg in Lincoln, Nebraska on May 10, 1950. Nancy grew up on a farm near Terril, Iowa. She enjoyed raising cattle and showing steers and horses in the county fair. She graduated from Terril High School where she played basketball, competed in track and field and twirled baton in the marching band.

She attended Spencer Business College for bookkeeping in Spencer, Iowa. After graduation she began her career with Morton Buildings in Spencer where she met her future husband Les. They were married on April 13, 1974 in Spencer.

Les and Nancy moved to North Dakota where she worked different bookkeeping jobs. After Les started Roughrider Building Systems she stayed home to help him run the business. In 2006 they bought the Enderlin Lumberyard and renamed it Circle R Lumber which they owned and operated together until the time of his death. Then Nancy and her son Cal took over the Circle R Lumber together along with the tire shop and the trucking business up until her death.

Nancy loved spending time with family and friends. She loved working in her yard with gardening, planting flowers, or just sitting in her yard relaxing. Nancy also had a huge love for horses.

Nancy is survived by her loving son Cal and his wife Sarah, loving granddaughter Calleigh Jo all of Nome, North Dakota; her brother Brian Moorberg Estherville, Iowa; three nephews Matt (Amber), Colby (Stacy), and Joe (Katie); four great nephews and one great niece. She is also survived by her uncle Dale (Fran) Whitaker of Newton, North Carolina.

She is preceded in death by her husband Les who died on May 24, 2021, her parents Joseph and Leona Moorberg, and her Aunt Eleanor Campbell.
