January 4, 1942 - December 9, 2022

Percy (Ed) James, 80, Fargo, North Dakota formerly of Valley City, North Dakota passed away at his home Friday, December 9, 2022. The funeral service will be held 3:00 pm Saturday, December 17, at Oliver-Nathan Funeral Chapel, Valley City. Pastor Les Koenig of the First Baptist Church, Valley City, will be officiating. Burial will be in St. Catherine's Cemetery in the spring of 2023.

Ed was the son of Percy Sr. and Opal James. He was born on January 4, 1942 in Monroe County, MO. Following high school, Ed served in the 204th Military Police Battalion of the US Army as a rifle expert.

Ed was married to Donna (Vandrovec) James for 48 years and together they made a home in the foothills of the southern Alberta where Ed raised and broke horses, including his favorite, Joker, and worked as a ranch manager. In 1986 they moved to a farm near Rogers, North Dakota where they raised their two daughters and son. Ed was a member of the First Baptist Church in Valley City. Later in life, Ed enjoyed his work as a driver for Valley City State University athletic teams and for South Central Transit. Ed and Donna retired to Fargo, ND in 2017.

Ed was known for his love of laughter and family. He is survived by his wife, Donna, and children Shane (Doreen) James, Jessica (Jeff) Gisi, Aaron (Taylor) James, and Sarah (Tom) Peckskamp and nine grandchildren.

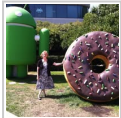

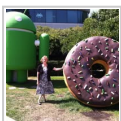

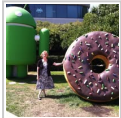
