



P. Gerhard Storhoff

March 8, 1917 - June 15, 2011

Paul Gerhard Storhoff was born March 8, 1917 to Adolph and Lena (Rodlin) Storhoff at Eastedge, ND. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Petri Lutheran Church of Nome, ND. Gerhard attended school at Eastedge. He worked for area farmers in North Dakota.

In 1941, he went to Portland, OR where he worked in the shipyards. He was drafted into the US Army in 1942 and served in Panama until his discharge in 1945. Following his discharge, he returned to ND where he farmed with his brother until retiring, and moving to Valley City. He later moved to Maryhill Manor in Enderlin, ND. He died there on June 15, 2011.

Gerhard is survived by a sister, Valborg Hoff of Bismarck; 3 brothers, Edmund of Nome, ND, Howard of Seattle, WA, and Richard of Moorhead, MN; many nieces and nephews; and a life long friend, Vernon Huseby of Fargo, ND.

He was preceded in death by his parents; 2 brothers, Edgar and Charles; 3 sisters, Evelyn Opdahl, Priscilla McGregor, and Ruth Abrahamsen; 2 nieces and 2 nephews.
