Richard William Vogel was born on January 10, 1922 to William and Evelyn (Oestreich) Vogel on a farm ten miles northeast of Rogers, ND known as the Logan farm. He attended his first eight years at the Logan School and graduated from Rogers High School in 1939.

On June 7, 1946, he was united in marriage to Marion Mason at Bethel Lutheran Church in Rogers. They first made their home on the Coleman farm northeast of Rogers. The following year, they moved to the Clarence Mason farm, which was Marion's family farm. The couple lived there for 32 years. In 1979, they moved into Rogers at which time their son, Everett, took over the farming operation.

He was involved in 4-H for over 70 years, and was a leader for 50 of those years. He served on several boards, such as the Barnes County Livestock Association, Anderson Township Board, Bethel Church Board, and the Barnes County 4-H Club Council. In 1992, he was inducted into the 4-H Hall of Fame at NDSU.

Richard is survived by his wife, Marion of Rogers; sons, Everett (Miriam) of Rogers and Todd (Cindy) of Marion, ND; grandchildren, Leah, Amanda, Justin, Michael, and Jeffrey; and a sister, Verna (Ralph) Schaefer of Valley City.

He was preceded in death by his parents; daughter and son-in-law, Valrey and Eugenio Arias; an infant son, Kirby Kim; and an infant daughter, Lynae.
