



## Rosemary Stephan

Rosemary Lillian Stephan, 86, formerly of Fingal, ND, died peacefully Thursday, July 9th at Bethany Homes, Fargo, surrounded by her loving family and the caring support of Hospice of the Red River Valley and the Bethany staff.

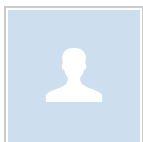
