July 25, 1918 - June 23, 2010

Ruth M. Nagle, 91, Valley City, North Dakota, died Wednesday, June 23, 2010, at the Sheyenne Care Center, Valley City.

Ruth Margaret Oxtan was born July 25, 1918 in Sherbrook Township, Steele County, North Dakota to Frank and Laura (Devlin) Oxtan. Ruth attended school in Sherbrook Township and Finley and graduated from Hope High School in 1936, and from Interstate Business College in Fargo, ND.

She married Erwin Kenneth Nagle June 12, 1940 in Hope. They lived in McClusky and Neche, ND before moving to Valley City in 1946 following Erwin's service with the U.S. Army (Europe) during WW II. They remained residents of 6th Ave. SE, Valley City, for 50 plus years. Erwin died in 1994. Ruth became a resident of Sheyenne Care Center in February of 2007.

Ruth was an active member of the Congregational Church of Christ, the American Legion Auxiliary and a member of a Valley City Red Hats group. She was a Cub Scout den mother, Sheyenne Care Center Volunteer, and worked several years at Red Owl Grocery in Valley City. Ruth is mostly remembered by family and friends as a gracious hostess, great homemaker, and a special mother and grandmother.

She is survived by seven sons, Robert (Linda), Bismarck, ND; David (Linda), Valley City, ND; Dan (Jacki), San Diego, CA; Lyle, Grand Forks, ND; Paul (Barbara), Moorhead, MN; Gene (Sue), Bismarck, ND; Don (Sandy), Grand Forks, ND; one brother, John Oxtan, Hope, ND; eleven grandchildren, nine great-grandchildren, and two great-great-grandchildren.

Ruth was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, one brother (Frank Jr. Oxton), two sisters (Francis Ann Oxton and Lois Warrey), and a grandson (Joshua Kerrigan).
